President's Message: These past nine months as a Human Life of Washington (**HLW**) chapter helps keep operating costs low because HLW covers state fees, insurance, registered agent, etc. This allows HLTC to focus on pro-life ministry work. Seven members along with pro-life groups, like Lacey WA Sacred Heart Respect For Life (**RFL**) and Students For Life of America (**SFLA**), came together to produce the Fall 2021 and Spring 2022 Newsletters. Many thanks to our readers who generously support protecting human life from conception to natural death. Our website, <u>HumanLifeTC.org</u>, enabled twenty of these associates including a pro-life billboard designer, Brad Haima of Canada, to volunteer their ideas and perspectives, to modernize an existing HLTC billboard and creating a second new billboard on display for over two months.

Politics- On May 2nd, a draft majority opinion from SCOTUS unprecedently leaked to the public. Overturned Roe does not make abortions go away in the USA. The leak might energize democratic party voters to push for legislation to guarantee abortions. Pro-life activists will need to keep on with continued strong, compassionate support to influence people's minds and hearts while providing practical help to those in need in Washington state.

Business– Amazon, etc. companies provide funding for employees to obtain abortions. Amazon will give its employees up to \$4,000 a year for travel expenses for elective abortions.

Scientific studies- Abortion restrictions showed 17% decrease from the median abortion rate. Without abortion insurance 25% more poor birthed their babies. Repealing Roe v Wade and allowing states to set abortion policies may reduce abortions nationally by 6 to 15 percent.

Opinion Letter to the Editor

Treat any human, no matter how small, no matter where they live, as you would have any human treat you anywhere, anytime from conception to 8 weeks to 9 months to 120 years.
