In a 9'x20' sized double booth at a discount price, 3 of our 6 pro-life billboard banners emphasized voting. Fairgoers scanned our HLTC website's voting guide QR code and received our business card. They signed up for our newsletter and/or as next year's education booth volunteers.

A mom took a picture of her homeschooled children who enjoyed looking at fetal models, posters, and tossing the ball game. Our pink wristband "Worth Waiting For" caused her tears of joy to flow for conceiving her kids.

The 12-week-old rubber fetus models opened fairgoers eyes. Pregnant women wanted the 12-week baby fetus model to know more about their new life within. A father was amazed that such a small human being, a 12-week-old fetus, has so many distinctly human features. Mothers and grandmothers showed their children stages of fetal development displays. A young boy spent time enjoying reading and looking at the ten gestational posters. Kids liked touching the stuffed mother polar bear holding her cub at the entrance of the booth.

When two pro-choice women and one pro-choice couple stopped at our booth, the two women said they had abortions and didn't regret it at all. The pro-choice senior couple with anger stated "My Body, My Choice!", "What about rape and incest!" and "There's nobody that helps the pregnant women!" The next day, a vendor lady at the fair gave us five yellow gerbera daisies for our HLTC team's gentle response to the senior couple.

General Election Dates & Deadlines

- October 18 Start of 18-day voting period (through Election Day). Ballots are mailed out and Accessible Voting Units (AVUs) are available at voting centers.
- October 28 Online and mail registrations must be received 8 days before Election Day. Register to vote in person during business hours and any time before 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
- **November 5** Deadline for Washington State voter registration or updates (in person only).
- **November 5** General Election Deposit your ballot in an official drop box by 8 p.m. on Election Day.
